Union Members Win Fight

To Lessen the Burden of New Security Training Regulations

United Voice has continued to meet with the Department of Consumer Affairs to discuss the burdens put on to members by the new security training requirements. Through these meetings members have secured a number of wins. These include:

- Recognition of prior learning (RPL)
- Extension to the time in which you are expected to train for the qualifications to **1st January 2013**.

All license holders should have or will receive a letter from the Department of Consumer Affairs outlining the new requirements.

Because of strong union membership, security workers have been able to make their voices heard. You have told the government policy makers that this financial burden is not on—and they have listened.

United Voice is continuing to work with employers and training providers on ideas as to how to minimise the cost of training. And we will continue to be a major stakeholder in decisions made about the security industry.
